Sections	Age	Word Count
Junior 1	9 yrs & under	Up to 300
Junior 2	10-12 years	Up to 500
Intermediate	13-17 years	Up to 700
Open	18+	Up to 2000

Poetry

Poems can be on **any subject** and of **any length** but must contain a **reasonable amount of Doric words**.

Sections	Age
Junior 1	9 yrs & under
Junior 2	10-12 years
Intermediate	13-17 years
Open	18+
